# Liquid silicone gel (Kelocote) Information Leaflet



#### What is Kelocote silicone gel?

Kelocote is a clear, self drying silicone gel. Silicone interferes with the scarring process and may help prevent over-scarring.

#### What is it used for?

We use Kelocote silicone gel to prevent or treat itchiness, redness or raised scarring.

### Do:

• Clean the area to be treated with warm soapy water and pat dry

• Wipe off any excess cream if you have massaged with Cream

• Apply a very thin layer of Kelocote gel

• Allow to dry for 4–5 minutes before putting on pressure garment or clothing—if it takes longer than this to dry, you are using too much

• Discuss any dermatological conditions (such as eczema or psoriasis) with your therapist

#### Don't:

- Use on open wounds
- Apply Kelocote too close to your eyes
- Apply over other skin treatments/products

Kelocote may stain clothes if not allowed to dry completely before dressing.

If the gel causes any redness or irritation, discuss with your therapist.
